

The project Change of view was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"

Participation: The project involved 240 citizens, notably 64 from Palić (Serbia), 47 from Érsekhalma community (Hungary), 23 from EGTS Pannonia (Croatia), 24 from Republikon Alapítváy (Hungary), 29 from Velka Ida community (Slovakia), 12 from the Klacr (Czech Republic) and 41 from Fundatia Diaspora (Romania).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Palić, Serbia, from 12/04/2019 to 14/04/2019.

Short description:

The day of **12/04/2019** was dedicated to the Kick off meeting and the Migration themed photo exhibition.

On the kick off meeting participants introduced themselves. The agenda and the purpose of the meeting was presented. Members got to know each other and exchanged their knowledge and experiences. The recent political, economic and social situation was overviewed.

An exhibition on the topic of the project was opened. Each partner invited a photographer to make images of his / her own country related to the theme of the project. The purpose of the photo exhibition was to get the individual delegations to learn about the situation and problems of European countries. The exhibition was followed by dinner, where areas of interest were formed.

The day of **13/04/2019** was dedicated to the Conference, Workshop, Cultural and Gastronomic program.

At the conference, participants presented topics that related to each partner and revealed the background of the topics, the ways to solve the problems and the way to go. The aim of the conference was to explore local specificities in the field of migration and tolerance, to get to know the situation, difficulties of each partner and to find common solutions to these major European issues. In connection with the project conference, on the second day of the meeting, 4 thematic workshops were held, the leaders of which came from the country raising the topic. They tried to find a solution to the problems at the conference by forming small work groups. The goal was international collaboration to examine / solve specific issues.

Representatives of local and partner settlements attended a cultural program. After the show, the participating citizens built relationships through a joint lunch and gastronomic program, where they cooked food that is specific to their countries. The goal was to present their knowledge through informal competition, which they then consume together.

The day of 14/04/2019 was dedicated to the Closing event.

On the Closing event participants presented the solutions developed at the workshops and discussed them more widely. They set up the collaborative principles that were planned based on this meeting. A problem solving database was created that can be used to solve the topics discussed during the project, adopted to the requirements of a particular country, region, city. The day ended with a joint lunch.
